Breakthrough Youth empowers 14to 24-year-olds to make responsible decisions that support their well-being for a lifetime.

Focus Areas

- Financial literacy
- Substance use/misuse prevention
- Healthy relationships, including safe sex practices
- Planning for career next steps

Financial Coaching

Financial Coaching provides tools and one-on-one support to help participants achieve their financial goals.

Examples of Goals

- Reducing or eliminating debt
- Building credit
- · Paying bills on time
- Saving money for life events

Helping Hands Auto Loans

Helping Hands Auto Loans help DCP program participants obtain auto loans with reasonable rates and terms.

Family Development Accounts

A Family Development Account is a savings account that provides income-eligible individuals a means of saving toward allowable expenses. Every dollar an account holder saves is matched by four dollars from public and private funders.

Allowable Expenses

- Buying a home
- Starting or expanding a business
- Furthering education
- Additional expense types may be allowed if a minor lives in the home.
